# SANCERRE ROUGE

## DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

This 1.5ha plot of Pinot Noir is situated on wonderful chalky-clay soils in Sancerre that yield 55hl/ha. Following the harvest the grapes were totally destemmed and maceration takes place for 15 days. Maturation occurs in stainless steel and the wine undergoes 3 rackings and mild filtration before bottling. This Pinot Noir from the Loire Valley has unusual fruitiness and gourmet notes.

## TASTING NOTES

A beautiful garnet colour with an open nose with notes of wild cherry, raspberries, wild strawberries with a hint of earthy spice and pepper. Delicate on the palate, with silky tannins, bright fruit and lovely balance on the finish.

## HOW TO SERVE

Serve between 14 and 16°C, with grilled white meats and mild cheeses such as Brie de meaux and Brillat Savarin. Ageing potential of 3 years.
