DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Grapes are taken from the Mont Battois hillside, facing Beaune. the name “Grèves” derives from the sandy and gravelly soil that dominates the land in this area. Separated from the Clos des Fèves by a narrow path this Chanson vineyard covers 2 hectares. After a classic winter, spring settled down with warm temperatures but cool weather in April. May was rainy and was followed by a warm summer with heatwaves. However, a few thunderstorms brought enough rain to allow the maturation of the grapes to continue. The harvest started early in September with excellent grapes. Vinification : whole bunch fermentation for approximately two weeks, the wines are then aged in their XVth century cellar for a period between 14 to 18 months. Moderate use of new oak.

TASTING NOTES

Bright ruby colour. Subtle floral Fragrances mixed with aromas of red berries and spices. Subtle vanilla note. Generous with a tight texture. Well-balanced. Expressive tannins on a well integrated oak. Refreshing and fruit aftertaste.

HOW TO SERVE

Red meat, grilled or with a sauce. Cheese selections, particularly local cheeses like Epoisses, Citeaux and Langres.
