DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

In the heart of the Premier Cru vineyards of Domaine Chanson is a plot which covers 4 hectares, in the center of the Beaune territory. It's soils are a mix of limestone and clay and it grows premium Pinot Noir grapes. After a classic winter, spring settled down with warm temperatures but cool weather in April. May was rainy and was followed by a warm summer of heatwaves. However, a few thunderstorms brought enough rain to allow the maturation of the grapes to continue. The harvest started in early september with excellent grapes
Vinification : whole bunch fermentation for approximately two weeks, the wines are then aged in their XVth century cellar for a period between 14 to 18 months. Moderate use of new oak.

TASTING NOTES

Bright ruby colour. Fragrances of violet mixed with intense aromas of ripe red berries (cherry and raspberry) mixed with liquorice. Subtle vanilla note. Well-balanced and complex. Tight and delicate texture. Elegant tannins. Very pure fruit. Long and spicy finish. Bright ruby. Intense aromas of black pinot fruit mixed with spices and violet. Mouth coating and complex. Tight texture. Delicate oak note. Long and spicy aftertaste.

HOW TO SERVE

Enjoy with red or white meat, "Boeuf Bourguignon" and variety of regional cheeses, in particular goat's cheese and Citeaux.
