# CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET

**CHANSON**  
En Bourgogne depuis 1750

## DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Three plots of vineyards from selected “vignerons”, ideally located in the heart of the village of Chassagne Montrachet - close to the Premiers Crus area. South, South-East orientation.

After a rainy winter, spring started with a very warm episode in April followed by cold temperatures in May. The warm weather settled down in early June. The summer was punctuated by several heat waves which engendered a lack of water, compensated by the presence of clay in many plots. The harvest started at the end of August, in outstanding conditions, grapes were fully ripe and healthy. The white wines are precise with a beautiful combination of fruit. Vinification : after a mild pressing, this wine was vinified and aged for 12 to 14 months in oak casks in their cellars of the XVth century. Moderate proportion of new oak.

## TASTING NOTES

Pale gold colour. Floral fragrances mixed with citrus fruit aromas. Delicate vanilla note. Punchy and complex. Deep and tight texture. Long and focused finish.

## HOW TO SERVE

To be enjoyed with foie gras, grilled fish, white meat and strong cheeses (Epoisses, Roquefort and Munster).
