DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Chanson owns a vineyard of 5.4 hectares in premier Cru "Les Vergeleses". One of the plots of this vineyard has been selected to produce this Pernand-Vergeleses village, its soils are clay and limestone. After a classic winter, spring settled down with warm temperatures. May was rainy and was followed by a warm summer with heatwaves. However, a few thunderstorms brought enough rain to allow the maturation of the grapes to continue. The harvest started in early september with excellent grapes. Vinification : whole bunch fermentation for approximately two weeks, the wines are then aged in their XVth century cellar for between 14 to 18 months. Moderate use of new oak.

TASTING NOTES

Dark ruby. Fragrances of violet mixed with aromas of ripe dark berries and hazelnut mixed with spices. Complex, well structured. Onctuous texture. Tense with muscular tannins. Outstanding finish with a hint of minerality.

HOW TO SERVE

Enjoy with grilled steak and a wide selection of French cheeses, in particular Brie.
