DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

The vineyard is located on the hill of the commune of Santenay, a small village South of the Côte de Beaune, near Chassagne Montrachet.

After a cool and rainy winter and a frost episode in April, the warm and dry weather in spring was welcomed for flowering. In July and August the weather was more demanding, becoming better again in early September with an Indian summer which ensured perfect maturation for the grapes. The harvest took place in mid September, with bright sunshine. The red wines give off beautiful aromas of ripe red berries with a sappy texture. Ageing took place in oak casks for 15 months.

TASTING NOTES

Bright ruby colour. Delicate fragrances of violet mixed with refreshing aromas of ripe red berries (raspberry) mixed with spices. Well-balanced and complex. Tight texture. Well-integrated tannins and delicate oak note. Long aftertaste.

HOW TO SERVE

To be enjoyed with roast meat or meat en sauce, games and most cheeses (especially Citeaux, Epoisses, Langres).
