DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Chablis' Grand Cru Les Preuses, situated at the northern extremity of the Grand Cru region, stands out as one of the smaller Grand Cru Climats, encompassing 11.4 hectares. Chanson carefully chooses vines positioned centrally within the plot, capturing the essence of this unique terroir and infusing the wine with its distinctive minerality.

After a mild winter, spring settled down with important variations of temperatures and abundant rain which engendered millerandage (small berries). Summer was warm punctuated by several heat waves and a few thunderstorms episodes which brought some water. The harvest started mid september under a bright sunshine. After a mild pressing, the wines are aged in oak casks for a period of 12 up to 14 months in our XVth century cellar. Moderate use of new oak.

TASTING NOTES

Pale gold colour. Floral fragrances mixed with white orchard fruit aromas and honey. Delicate mineral expression. Well balanced and complex. Creamy with a tight texture. Long finish.

HOW TO SERVE

Foie gras, shellfish, fish, white meat as well as regional cheeses such as Epoisses, Citeaux, Brillat Savarin or Comté.
