In the right expert hands, it's possible to get so much more out of Pinot Meunier, especially when grown on the chalky slopes of Exton Park.

TASTING NOTES

Made from 100% Pinot Meunier picked from our meticulously trained fourth plot, this delicate wine combines a complex, developed nose with subtle oriental characteristics. The palette offers incredible intricacy and remarkable purity, with freshly cut flowers, white peach and bright tangerine notes.

How to serve

As an aperitif, this wine excels when paired with lightly smoked trout or lovingly cured jamón ibérico. The wine's subtle hint of spice also marries well with Middle-Eastern cuisine.
