It was his vision to establish one of the leading English sparkling wine producers in a Hampshire valley that he had been farming for decades. To do this, Malcolm knew he needed the very best ingredients.

DETAILS OF PRODUCTION

Exton Park sits in the rolling chalk hills of Hampshire. We hand-harvest grapes from our single vineyard, pressing plot by plot before storing in our library of reserve wines. Our winemaker selects from this archive, creating our unique Reserve Blends. 60 acres of Hampshire, bottled.

The Exton Park RB28 Blanc de Noirs is a limited production wine, with only small amounts produced each year, and is a firm favourite of our premium restaurant partners.

TASTING NOTES

100% Pinot Noir from across our single vineyard. The expressive, fruity, lifted nose leads on to a rounded and balanced palate, showing tropical fruit, white pepper and some richness. Precise, charming, and English to its core.

HOW TO SERVE
